

- Routine appointments and check ups
- Schedule a level two ultrasound
- Get your Glucose tested!
- Time for a prenatal genetic screening!
- Get Immunizations
- Look into childbirth classes

#### **Third Trimester**

Third Trimester Check-List

- Keep track of your baby's movements
- Keep up with your appointments. Learn about third trimester prenatal visits and tests
- Take a tour of where you will be giving birth
- Choose your baby's pediatrician
- Be prepared! Make sure you have your baby gear ready
- Create a birth plan
- Take a breastfeeding class. OHI will order a double electric breast pump if you decide to breastfeed
