What is the 340b Drug Pricing Program? It is a government program where drug companies sell medications to eligible healthcare organizations (like Ocean Health Initiatives) at very low prices!

Can anyone use the pharmacy?

Ocean Health Initiatives Pharmacy is a private pharmacy only for OHI. The 340b program is restricted to current patients of OHI and prescriptions from OHI's providers.

What if I have insurance?

You can still use the pharmacy! You can either use your insurance or pay the 340b price. OHI Pharmacies accept many plans including Medicaid. Check with your Ocean Health Initiatives Pharmacist today!


