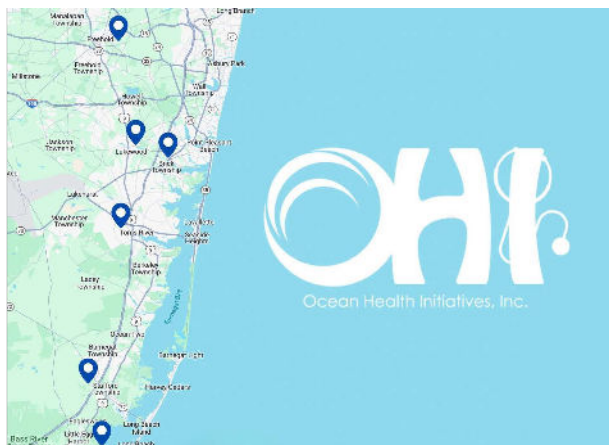

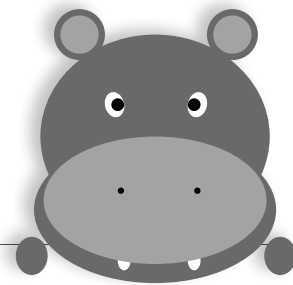
ABOUT

- Newborn
- Under 6 weeks
- 2 months
- 4 months
- 6 months
- 12 months
- 15 months
- 18 months
- 24 months*

*After 24 months, your child should have one exam annually
